Registrar**

K. Eugene (Gene) Eulinger, Jr. has served as Registrar at Missouri Western State University since December of 2002. Prior to that he served as the Registrar at Linn State Technical College for four years. He graduated from the University of Missouri-Columbia with a B.S. in Agriculture in 1965. He also earned an M.S. Ed. Degree from Northwest Missouri State University and Educational Specialist and Doctor of Education degrees from the University of Missouri-Columbia.

As a member of MACRAO, Gene has served as a member and chairman of the Professional Development Committee, as vice-president elect, and this year is serving as vice-president for programming. He has attended MACRAO and AACRAO conferences each year since becoming a Registrar.

Melanie lives in Webster Groves with her husband Gary, daughters Miranda (7) and Kyla (1), and dog Sadie.



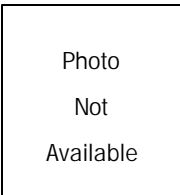
**Vice President Elect for Programs and Projects**

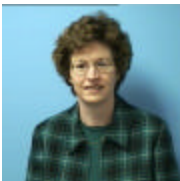
